



Allen Edwards' trip to Rwanda - July 2022

Hi, I'm Allen. For those of you who couldn't join the service at St Francis' Church last Sunday, my wife Jean and I have been worshipping at St Francis' since we moved to the area in December. I am a retired engineer and church minister.

As part of Eagle's Wings Ministries UK, a small mission organisation, I have made several trips to Rwanda to train church leaders. On the 3rd July I fly out to Rwanda for my fifth visit.

Three of us will be leading one two-day and one four-day conference on Church Leadership for lay church leaders from the Kigali and Shyira Diocese of the Anglican Church in Rwanda.

These church leaders are generally running churches of 100-200 people in their local villages with little support, in some cases with little or no theological training.

During these courses we will be covering a range of topics: Preaching, Leadership, Church Growth, Preparing & Leading Bible Study and Strategies for Evangelism.

There will be ~76 attending the conference in the Rwandan capital, Kigali and 276 at the conference in Ruhengeri in the Northwest of Rwanda, close to the boarder with DR Congo.

This is our first time in the Shyira Diocese.

It's a busy programme:

4th July arrive in Kigali.

6th, 7th Conference in Kigali for ~70 Lay Church Leaders.

8th Travel by road to Ruhengeri.

10th Preaching in Ruhengeri.

11th-14th Conference in Ruhengeri for 276 Lay Church leaders.

15th Return to Kigali.

16th Fly back to Heathrow.

The challenges for us will be the different language and culture and coping with teaching and preaching with a translator using Kinyarwanda, English and French.

We would value your prayers for the following:

- Preparation of the teaching material in Kinyarwanda and the practicalities of presenting this using a translator.
- That the travel will go smoothly.
- Our health during the visit.
- The anointing of the Holy Spirit on our ministry.
- Our wives while we are away.
- The lay leaders that they will be touched afresh through God's Word and by his Spirit.
- The ongoing work of the churches in Rwanda.
